An appeal will automatically be denied if the studettes not attend and does not give reasonable notice of inability to attend.

### STAGE III APPEAL TO THE EDUCATION COUNCIL APPEAL TRIBUNAL

If an appeal of an educational decision is denied by the EducatApppaeals Committee, the student may appeal to the Education CounAppeal Tribunal. The grounds for a review by the Education Council Appeal Tribunaere as follows:

- x Due process was not followed in Stages II or
- x The Appeal of Educational Decisions Policy was incorrectly applied in Statles I
- x Evidence that might reasonably change the outcome of the appeal was not available at the EducationalAppeal hearing, or the tudent was not permitted to present such evidence
- x The decision was inconsistent with the principles of natural justice

Dissatisfaction with the decision of the ducational Appeals Committees not a ground for review.

### CommitteeMembership
