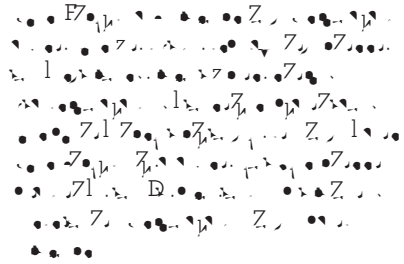

Certificate: Graduates receive a certificate after completing a program of study that is equivalent to a two-year program at a university. The certificate is awarded to students who have completed all the requirements of the program and have achieved a minimum grade point average of 2.0.

Advanced Certificate: Graduates receive an advanced certificate after completing a program of study that is equivalent to a two-year program at a university. The advanced certificate is awarded to students who have completed all the requirements of the program and have achieved a minimum grade point average of 2.5.

Honours Credential: Graduates receive an honours credential after completing a program of study that is equivalent to a two-year program at a university. The honours credential is awarded to students who have completed all the requirements of the program and have achieved a minimum grade point average of 2.5.

Associate Degree: Graduates receive an associate degree after completing a program of study that is equivalent to a two-year program at a university. Continuing Education Certificate of Program Completion: Graduates receive a continuing education certificate of program completion after completing a program of study that is equivalent to a two-year program at a university. The certificate is awarded to students who have completed all the requirements of the program and have achieved a minimum grade point average of 2.0.

Training Group Certificate: Graduates receive a training group certificate after completing a program of study that is equivalent to a two-year program at a university. The training group certificate is awarded to students who have completed all the requirements of the program and have achieved a minimum grade point average of 2.0.
